7. Determination for biosafety level and period of IBC oversight:

The Committee determined that **BSL-2 containment facilities and practices** are required for AGTC-501 since it consists of an adeno-associated viral (AAV) vector administered by injection in a clinical setting.

The Committee determined that IBC oversight will continue for **3 months after the last subject's last dose of AGTC-501 locally**, provided all other criteria for study closure are also met.

The Institutional Representative stated that the photo is of a regular trash can but that the lab does have biohazardous waste containers, which are labelled with biohazard symbols.
- 5. The Committee recommended that photos of the labelled biohazardous waste containers and posted biohazard signage, be provided to IBC Services.
- 6. The Committee recommended that a sharps container be placed inside the Biological Safety Cabinet (BSC) during study agent preparation.
